Requirements for Attending Worship

- Masks are required. If you have a mask, please put it on before entering the building. If not, a mask will be provided at each entrance along with hand sanitizer.
- You must use either the elevator entrance or the front entrance to enter the building. The basement entrance will not be open.
- No gathering in the narthex before, during, or after worship.
- As you enter the building, your temperature will be taken using a no-touch infrared thermometer. Per CDC guidelines, anyone with a temperature of 100.4 or greater will be asked to leave and it is suggested that they contact their healthcare professional.
- If you have an offering, please place it in one of the offering plates (located near the front entrance and by the elevator.)
- If your temperature is less than 100.4, you will immediately go and find a seat in the sanctuary.
- Pews will be roped off in order to maintain 6-foot social distancing. Social distancing must be practiced before, during, and after the service.
- Greeters will dismiss people at the end of the service starting with the back rows. You must wait for the greeter to dismiss your row.
- There will be no choir.
- On communion Sundays, prepackaged communion cups with wafer and juice will be used. Ushers will assist any congregants who need help opening them. Ushers will wear a mask and gloves when distributing the elements. Small trash bags will be placed in the pews for disposal of the used cups.
