Transitional Conference Minister

The MMSC Conference Council, at a special meeting on March 13, 2021, has hired Rev. Mary W. Nelson to serve as our Transitional Conference Minister. Rev. Nelson begins her position with us on May 1, 2021. This transition period will last approximately 18 months. Rev. Nelson is a lifelong "UCCer" and comes to us with a wealth of experience in various settings across the United Church of Christ. Most recently, she served for seven years as a Regional Minister (ACM) in the Connecticut/Southern New England Conference. For the anticipated near-term, Rev. Nelson will work remotely from Massachusetts, and will establish a second home base in Missouri Mid-South when travel and in-person gathering are more widely possible.
